Representatives from the Milton District Hospital Foundation (MDHF) and Halton Healthcare Services (HHS) were presented with a cheque for \$64,000 by Mayor Gord Krantz at the October 23rd Town of Milton Council Meeting. The money, part of the Mayor's Legacy Fund, was donated toward the MDHF's CT Scanner Campaign.

"I have seen our community grow by leaps and bounds over the last 25 years," noted Mayor Krantz. "A CT Scanner will ensure the best medical care is available for Milton and area residents right in their community. I think of this donation as a great investment in our community's healthcare."

Kim Mason, President of the Milton District Hospital Foundation and Co-Chair of the CT Scanner Campaign, expressed her thanks on behalf of the Foundation and the Hospital.

"Every year more than 2,900 patients at MDH require a CT Scan," explained Ms. Mason. "With the addition of a CT Scanner at MDH, patients will no longer have to leave their community for this important test. This generous donation brings us one step closer to reaching our goal of \$3.5 million needed to purchase the new scanner and renovate the existing Diagnostic Imaging Department."

"As Mayor of the Town of Milton for the past 25 years, Mayor Krantz has always been extremely supportive of our Milton District Hospital and again today we thank him for his generous spirit and unwavering support," said John Oliver, President and CEO of Halton Healthcare Services. "I would like to congratulate Mayor Krantz on reaching this momentous milestone in his career."

The Milton Chamber of Commerce established the Legacy Fund in 2005, to commemorate Mayor Krantz's 25th Anniversary as Mayor of the Town of Milton. The Chamber raised more than \$127,000 for the Fund, which was held in trust for the Mayor to distribute to worthwhile causes at his discretion.
